

Chinese Government Scholarship (Bilateral Program)

---Pre-Admission Letter for CSC Scholarship(Type

A)

Chinese Government Scholarship (Bilateral Program) accords with the cooperation and exchange agreements or consensus reached by the Chinese government and the governments and institutions of other nations. It is open to undergraduates, postgraduates, general and senior scholars. The scholarship can be full or partial. Applicants should apply to the dispatching authorities or Chinese Embassies/Consulates in their home countries for Chinese Government Scholarship candidate qualification.

The Pre-Admission Letter is only issued to applicants who apply for the Chinese Government Scholarships (Type A) through dispatching authorities or Chinese Embassies/Consulates in their home countries of their host countries. Applicants who have received the Pre-Admission Letter can submit the Pre-Admission Letter together with other documents when applying for the Chinese Government Scholarship (Bilateral Program), which is known as CSC-Type A.

If you want to Chinese Government Scholarship- High Level Postgraduate Program (also known as CSC-Type B), please do not ask for Pre-Admission Letter.

The Pre-Admission Letter is not equivalent to the final Admission Notice. It is only used for applying Chinese Government Scholarship (Type A) in your country.

Period of application

Now to March 31, 2024 (except legal holidays).

How to Get A CUC Pre-Admission Letter (TYPE A)

1. Send your digital documents along with your email to guoyuexin@cuc.edu.cn. Please put in “Pre-Admission Letter for CSC-type A + your full passport name” as the email subject. In the email, you shall inform the name of the major you are willing to apply for, either in English or in Chinese.
2. We will issue the CUC Pre-Admission Letter (digital copy) in 5 working days (except for holidays) upon receiving your documents. Please check your emails.

Documents Required

1. A copy of the passport information page, which must be an ordinary passport within the validity period. Passport expiration date should be later than September 2024.
2. Highest academic qualifications and degree certificates in English or Chinese, which must be original or notarised, either in Chinese or English; if the originals are not in Chinese or English, notarised translations in Chinese or English are required. The prospective diploma winners can first provide proof of expected graduation(either in Chinese or English), which should be stamped with the official seal of the university too ;
3. A study or research proposal of not less than 800 words. Clearly state the full name of the degree and major being applied for;
4. Applicants for undergraduate degrees should provide scanned copies of HSK certificates with Level 5 or above and individual scores of 60 or above (valid within two years); applicants for master's and doctoral degrees in Chinese-taught majors should provide scanned copies of the original HSK-6 certificates and transcripts (valid within two years). Applicants for master's degree and doctoral degree in English-taught majors whose mother language is not English are required to provide a scanned copy of the original TOEFL score of 79 or above or IELTS score of 6.0 or

above (valid within two years.)

5. Transcripts. Scanned transcripts should include all the course grades from the undergraduate, master's (if any) and doctoral (if any) levels of study up to the most recent semester and should be stamped with the official seal of the university. If the original transcript is not in Chinese or English, a notarised Chinese or English translation is required.

6. Due to problems of the CSC system, please refer to the current year's actual available majors *Communication University of China 2024 Undergraduate Admission Majors Catalogue for International Students, Communication University of China 2024 Master Admission Majors Catalogue for International Students, Communication University of China 2024 Doctor Admission Majors Catalogue for International Students.*
